



OUR REGION

Marche is a region situated in the center of Italy, near the Appennini's mountains. It is a territory characterized by different cultural, culinary and artisan traditions.

Its peculiarity concerns the diversity of territory. There are mountains, hills, plains, and sea, in fact, the region overlooks the Adriatic Sea.





URBINO

Urbino is Unesco Heritage for its cultural wealth. During the 15° century the city was one of the great European cultural capitals. The Ducal Palace, a Renaissance building, is one of the most important monuments in Italy.





Raffaello Sanzio, also known as **Raphael**, was born in Urbino in 1483, and was an Italian painter and architect of the High Renaissance.

His work is admired for its clarity of form. Together with Leonardo da Vinci and Michelangelo, he forms the traditional trinity of great masters of the time.

Raphael was enormously productive, ran an unusually large workshop and, despite his early death at the age of 37, left a large body of work.





FANO

Fano is the city of fortune for the legendary temple, the *Fanum Fortunae*, that gave it its name.

Fano is also the city of Augustus for the monumental honorary door the **Arch of Augustus**.

Today is a beach resort and it is the third city in the region by population after Ancona and Pesaro.

Fano is famous for its **Carnival**.

UNIVERSITY OF URBINO CARLO BO

The University was founded as **Law school** in **1506** by Guidobaldo da Montefeltro, Duke of Urbino, with the name of *Collegio dei Dottori* ("school of doctors").

Starting from the 1960s/70s, under the guidance of Carlo Bo as Rector and in the following years, the University enjoyed unprecedented growth in size and prestige.

The University of Urbino currently has **six departments** and **two institutes** and counts 14.721 students.


OUR EXCELLENCE

A curiosity: according to tradition, Casciotta was the favourite cheese of Michelangelo and Pope Clement XIV. It is a cheese protected by the PDO mark, which preserves and protects regionally produced foods.



INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS

For a long time, the Italian territory, has been characterized by the presence of industrial districts.

An industrial district is an **agglomeration** of small to medium-sized enterprises within a well-defined geographical area. Each company is specialised in a certain phase of the same production chain.

Marche is also famous for the industrial district of shoes.

It is mainly present in the **south** of the region. In fact, it develops between Macerata and Fermo.


In this district **footwear** and parts of footwear such as soles are produced .

Nero Giardini MADE IN ITALY




